Exhibit Button Display at Wichita Art Museum

In conjunction with the Kansas State Antique Button display now on exhibit at the Wichita Art Museum, 619 Stackman Drive, the Kansas Button Society is meeting at the museum.

A feature of the session was the address by Mrs. Anna Goetz of Pryor, Okla., Saturday night concerning her recent six-month tour of Germany. Of special interest, was the display of a button taken from the army of Frederick the Great in the early 1800's.

The meet and display are under the auspices of the Sunflower Button Club, the Wichita organization. Both were opened Saturday and the display will be shown for the

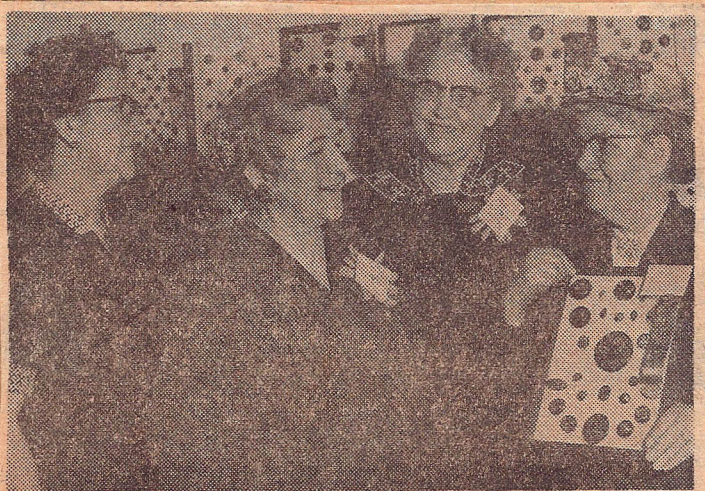
last time Sunday from 1 until 5 p.m.

The collection consists of over 500 trays with from 25 to 42 buttons on each ranging from antiques to moderns. The showing consists of buttons ornamented with pearls and other jewels, colored glass, paper weights, picture buttons, and many military buttons with a history attached to each.
